## Demonstration



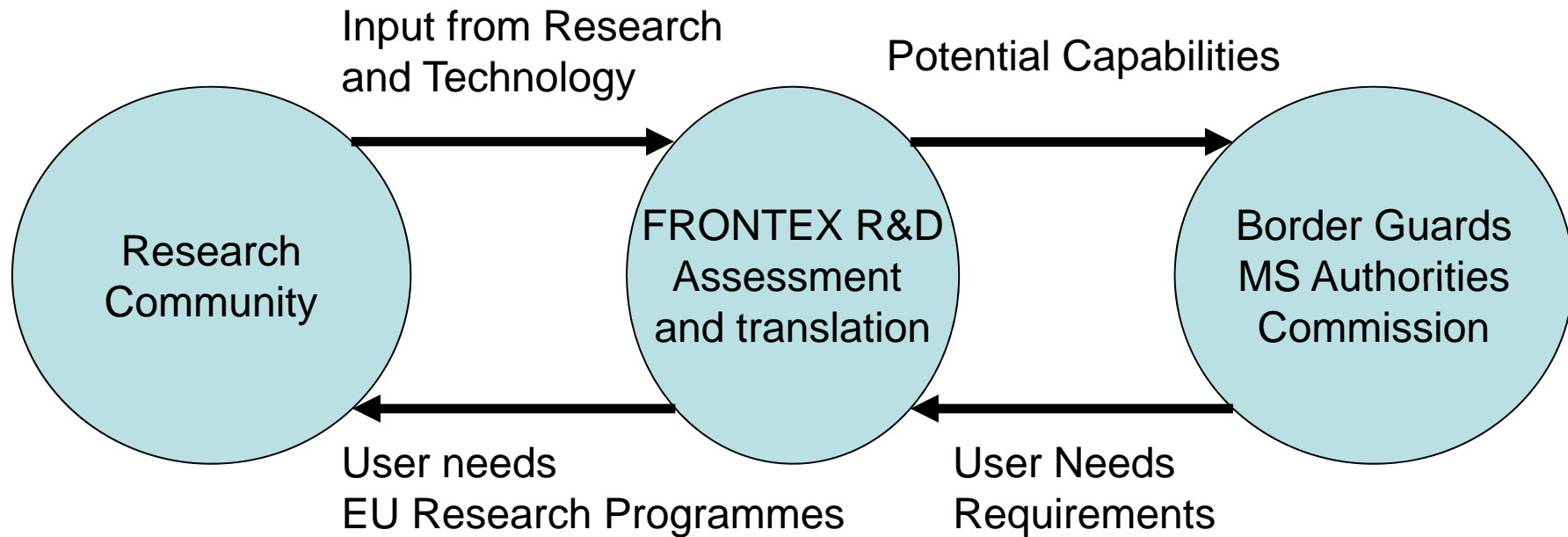
- What should be demonstrated?

- Demonstration programme ***European-wide integrated maritime border control system***
- Frontex has supported drafting the call
- Frontex has formed groups of end-users to harmonise requirements
- Frontex jointly with Commission and Coast Guards develops guidelines for validation
